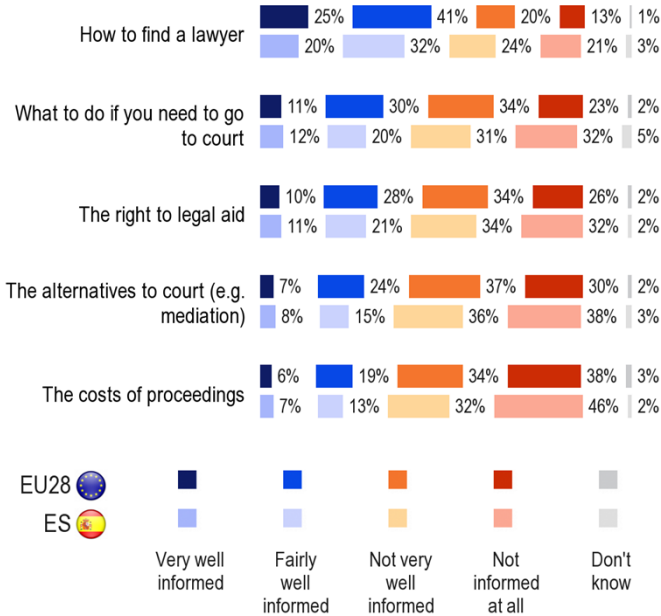

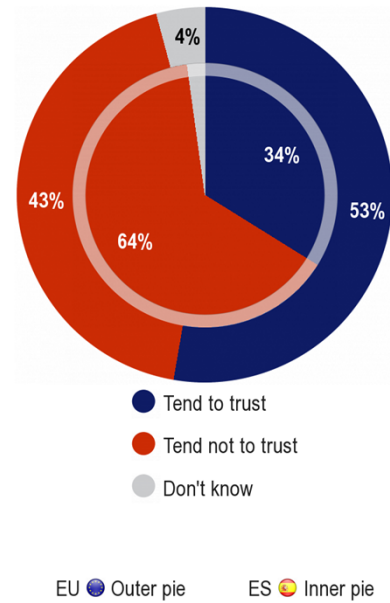

Q2. How informed or not do you feel about the justice system in (OUR COUNTRY) on each of the following topics?



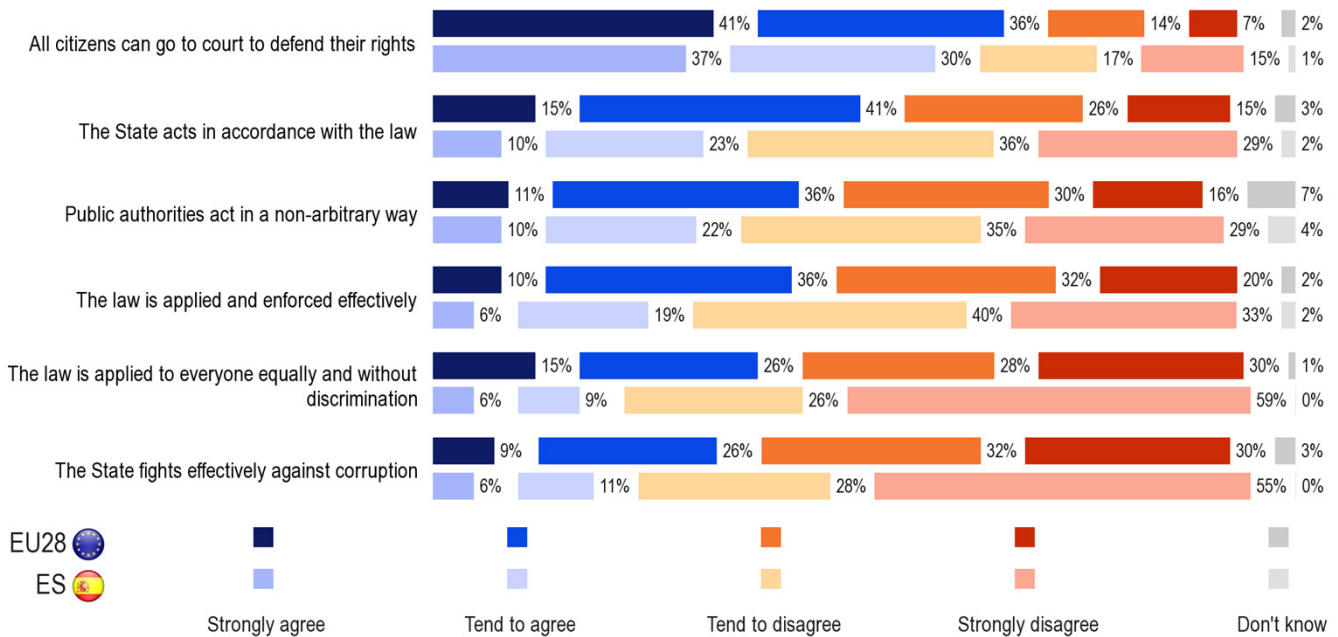

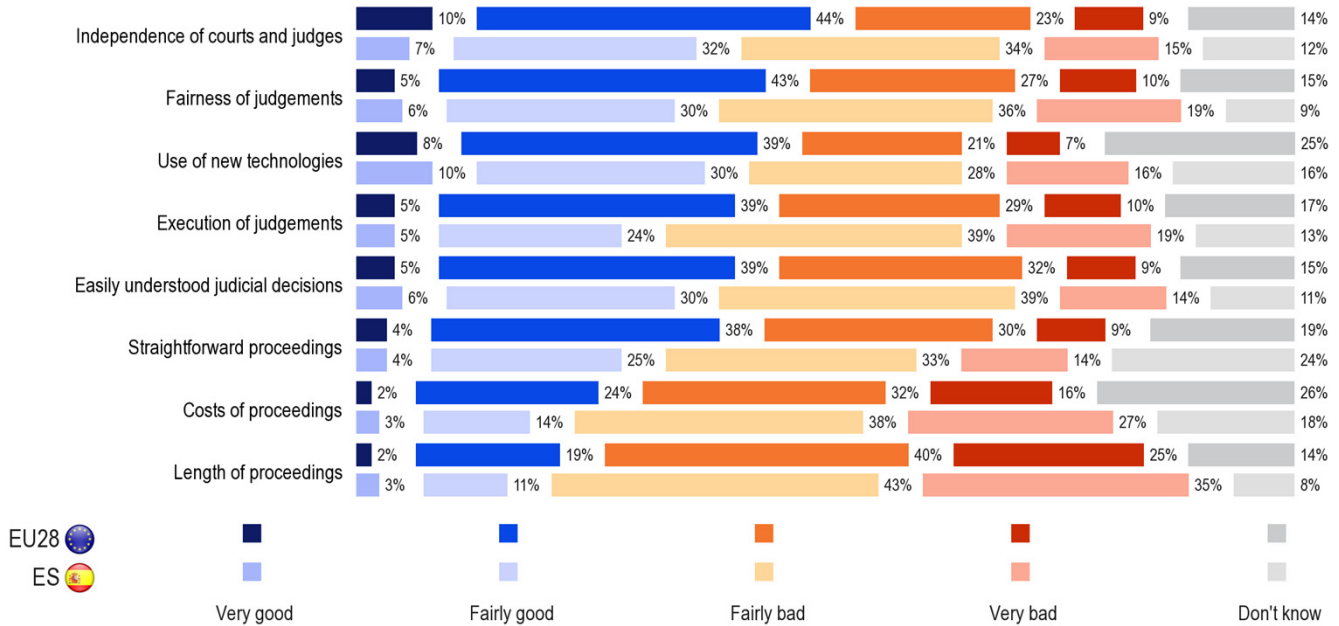

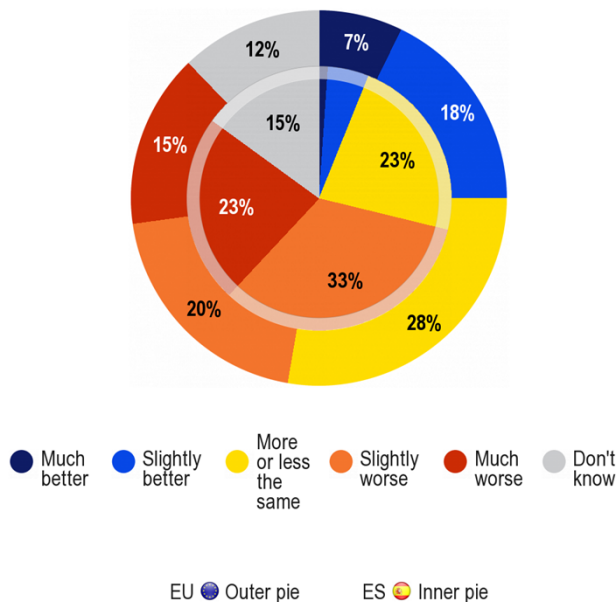
